EMAIL SCAM - The ICT department of the Archdiocese is drawing to our attention the concerning rise in scam email targeting our parishioners. These emails impersonate the parish priest, often using a similar email name and masking the real email address. They typically request the recipient to purchase Amazon or other gift cards as gifts for the priest. A number of parishioners have fallen victim to these scams, with some individuals losing up to £600 to the fraudsters. And so, as a matter of policy we will: never purchase gift cards as gifts for the parish priest based on an email request, unless we have verified the request directly in person or through trusted means. -double -check any suspicious email by directly contacting the parish office. -avoid sharing personal of financial information in response to unsolicited emails.
